Hotel Booking: Students are responsible to book for their own room. Mention that you are an Avalon School of Astrology student to get the above discounted rate. The hotel has a free shuttle from and to the Gainesville, FL airport. The airfare to fly to Gainesville, FL is sometimes cheaper than flying to Orlando or Jacksonville. The next nearest airport is Jacksonville, FL which is about a 1½ hour drive. Orlando, FL airport is about a 2 hour drive, and Tampa airport is about a 2½ hour drive. For most people it will be most convenient to fly into Gainesville and arrange with the hotel to pick you up in the shuttle. Otherwise you would have to rent a car from one of the larger airports in Jacksonville, Orlando, or Tampa.

We can also post on the discussion board your arrival and leave times so you know when your classmates will be here. A few of you will be driving but most will be flying in.

Graduation Weekend Schedule: There will be no online classes on Thursday (January 15). This will be a 2-day intensive on Friday, January 16 and Saturday, January 17.

Location: Classes are at the Avalon School, which is about 2 miles from the hotel. There will cars taking you back and forth from the hotel and school in the morning and evening.
